Pityriasis rubra pilaris is a chronic disease of unknown

* **Clinical picture:**

- 1) Circumscribed follicular keratoses
- 2) Erythema and scaling of the face
- 3) Diffuse scaling of the scalp

4) Palmoplantar keratoderma

5) Psoriasisiform patches

6) Erythroderma

7) The nail are thickened, discolored and brittle



* Treatment of PRP:

- 1) Salicylic acid 3-5%
- 2) Systemic retinoids in severe cases
- 3) Methotrexate in severe cases
