
How to avoid haze in advanced ablation?

- 2. Intraoperative:
 - Mitomycin C application (0.02%).
 - Washing the bed with cold BSS every
- 3 Ds to lessen the thermal effect of laser ablation

How to avoid haze in advanced ablation?

3. Postoperative:

- Avoid early removal of contact lens before complete epithelial healing.(early onset haze)
- Long term topical steroids therapy .(late onset haze)
- Avoid sunrays exposure. (Late onset haze)



PRK is a good alternative to LASIK as regard safety and corneal stability, however it carries some problems especially haze and epithelial healing problems.

LASIK is better in straight forward cases especially with ultrathin flaps.
